



Goals and The Assigned Task.

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Heb 3:12

12 See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God

Unbelief comes from an evil heart.

1 Tim 4:1-2

The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons.
NIV

There are teachings from demons, teachings' spirit. Be careful with your capacity to listen. It is one of Jesus's warnings, be careful how you hear.

Every bible teacher and leader must be careful about his hearing. Verse two tells you the inner condition about those who become mediumistic of evil spirit, and it is the state of their conscience.

- *Pray that the Lord will grant in our ministry of healing that we will only grant healing to those whose mind needs healing, because many people have sick mind.*
- *Pray that the Lord will help us begin to render inner healing, especially with dysfunctional inner disorder.*
- *Pray that the Lord will broaden our spectrum of inner healing.*

In our healing ministry, we need to cure people.

Acts 20:24

4 However, I consider my life worth nothing to me, if only I may finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me — the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace.

Paul summarises in a very simple sentence his work. My task, I want to finish my task, and then he explains what his task is: to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. He knew his task. He knew it very clearly. He could state it very clearly. So, what is your task. In all the many things that you plan to do, what is your task?

For those who set goals, they must ask and answer the question: what is the main thing, what is the essential thing that Jesus wants me to do in 2017?

What is your task? In the many things that you do, what are you called to do? What is the main thing that you are called to do?

Setting and accomplishing goals is not doing many things. You can work very hard and do nothing. You can cover a lot of distance and go nowhere. You must decide where you are going, that is why they call it "goals". You go round and round and round, exert a lot of efforts and go nowhere.

Don't let your life to be a merry-go-round, having excitement and going nowhere.

What is the main thing you will do next year?

What is the one thing you will do next year?

What is that one thing??

This one thing I do, what is it for you?

If you have not defined it for any year, you don't have a goal.

A goal is not activities, a goal is not a series of accomplishment.

A goal: I want to finish my task, that is what the apostle Paul says; the task of testifying to the gospel of God's grace. It was clear to him, what he must do and where and when.

And he says, "I have reasons to be proud of my work, starting from Jerusalem, all around to Illyria, that is Yugoslavia, I have fully preached the gospel, following a pioneering distinction.

What is your task?

What is your work

What is your service?

What is your ministry?

That is what it means to have a goal.

A multitude of activities is not a goal.

"this one thing I do...."until you know that one thing that summarises the expectations of Jesus on your life, you have not goal and you cannot set a goal. And many activities every month will not constitute a goal, it is that one thing that is called a burden.

Attached to the burden may be ten thousand activities, but the person who has a burden is doing one thing.

Your goal is that for which you are ready to give up your life. It is something that is more important for you than your life. The apostle Paul is saying, it does not matter to me when I am sick, I have only one burden, I am under the hurry to finish something. He says, "if I don't have a house, provided I get this".

Every movement that is rooted on experiences has a short term of life. Only what is planted on truth will endure.

The Lord Jesus said that the kingdom of God starts like a mustard seed, and when it grows.....

Growth invites demons, when we explode, in all growth and largeness, all explosions provide high places for demons. Jesus warned us that when his kingdom succeeds, the birds of the air come and stay there. In the parable of the sower, those birds of the air are demons. For consistency of interpretation, the birds of the air in the parable of the sower can be different from the birds of the air in the parable of the mustard. Growth brings demons.

Pray that the brethren will magnify their ministry

We should not just be excited with phenomenalism, we need truth, we need a framework of truth. We need experiences that have a point of reference and where truth is not built, reference of all experiences, those experiences porous and are to be

rejected, that is the Colossians error. A lot of spiritual experiences out of the frame of revelation, and Paul warns the Colossians.

Col 2:8

8 See to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy, which depends on human tradition and the basic principles of this world rather than on Christ.

Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. 19 He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow.
