We are not in church here. We are in school. The laws, the disciplines in school are different from those in the church. So let us bring our minds back in school. Because of the gap between the last school and this one, we want to remind you why we are here. We are school.

Goal of the School of Knowing and Serving God (SKSG)

The school of Knowing and serving God, one of the department of our ministry, has three goals:

1. God's initial need: to produce **workers**, servants of God, ministers of the new covenant, people who have laid down their lives on the altar, to serve God totally. Produce people who will find it a privilege to serve in the ministry.
2. Make sure that as a ministry, the local churches we plant in homes, in villages, in cities and in nations are stable **churches**. We will share with you what it means to have a stable church. Because many churches are not stables because of a certain number of reasons.
3. Make sure that the message that God has given to work through Brother Zach, to whom God gave the message, spread. So the **spread of our message**.

Therefore, when you come, through you, we want to accomplish these three goals. We are praying, we are teaching, pleading with God that through you, in Germany, God will give us a co-worker. A Co-worker who may be local, who may be in a nation, who we may send somewhere in Europe, or in Asia, or in South America or in Central America or in the Caribbean, or wherever God opens us doors. We also pray that through you, God will give us stable churches.

The bride of Christ is the church. When is the bride qualified to tell the bridegroom "Come". There are over 3500 villages in India. We are asking ourselves, "how do we make sure that in all these villages, in all our churches, the message that God has given us, get spread?" In Myanmar, most of our churches are in villages. How do we get to them? Also in Indonesia. The SKSG shall answer that question.



Pray that from here, God will grant us to pursue these goals.

We pray that God will enable us to succeed. Because of the successes of a teaching ministry is that it produces co-workers. A Bible teacher must produce workers. I want us to go to the beginning.

What is the goal of our ministry?

Goal of Christian Missionary Fellowship International (CMFI)

Our goal is three fold:

1. We must make sure that we preach the gospel to 10 billion inhabitants, as if everything depends on us. We must not think that they are other ministries. Yesterday at the prayer evening, we asked God for 50 people who will preach the gospel to 20 people every month. We must be committed with everything we have, we are that every human being on planet earth hears the full gospel: every German, every African,

every American, every Australian... must bear the glory gospel of our saviour Jesus Christ who came on earth and died for us. To this goal, we must put in everything we have, holding nothing back. We must put in all of our energy, all of our talents, all of our gifts, all of our money. We must put in our wives, our children, our homes. Every woman must invest her pots. Our fridges, our cars must be invested into the glory of God. **C.T. Studd said, "If Jesus is God and he died for me, nothing is too big for me to give to him."**

It is to this goal, that we are inviting you, to come and share with us. Corona Virus shall not stand on our way. How many people have died from the Corona Virus? So if we delay, more people will go to the lake of fire. People are dying. We must decide that the gospel gets to them before they die. When you go to bed at night, dream about the goal, about the lost, about the perishing souls of men. Time is against us. We are living the last hour of the last days. Every means shall be used for the gospel to get to the lost. Many of you are on Facebook. Have you sent a gospel message to all our followers? WhatsApp? LinkedIn, Instagram, Twitter? If not, on the judgement day, someone may say, I did not know that this one was a believer. He never preached the gospel to me. And the Lord warned Ezekiel saying **"when I say to a wicked person, "You will surely die", and you do not warn them or speak out to dissuade them from their evil ways in order to save their life, that wicked person will die for their sin, and I will hold you accountable for their blood." (Ezekiel 3:18).**

2. The Lord has commanded us, that from the 10 billion people, we shall **give him 1 billion disciples in 250 countries, scattered in 25 million house churches by 2065, who render to the Lord Jesus total obedience.** If the 1 billion disciple do not render to Christ total obedience to Christ in all things, then we have failed our goal. If the disciples do not render total obedience to Christ, we will not be able to produce co-workers, nor will we be able to produce stable local churches, nor be able to spread our message.

3. Finally, through us, there must be **a Christ glorifying, earth shaking and heaven brandling revival.**

The characteristics of a goal

We must learn a number of things about goals. A goal must

- Be precise
- Be measurable
- Be accountable
- Have a precise time for its accomplishment

Each one should be asking what would be the contribution of Germany. You must ask, what will be your contribution?

God in creation and God in redemption



What does God do at creation and what does God do at redemption?

God at creation and God at redemption are the same. We will prove it to you via the scriptures.

Analogy N°1

Creation

Genesis 1:1-2 "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters."

In the beginning, God had to start creation. The earth that God had to create had three characteristics.

1. The earth was formless
2. The earth was empty
3. There was darkness

Redemption

These are the three characteristics of an unbeliever: He is formless, empty and dark.

Analogy N°2

Creation

At creation, the Bible says that the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. God did not start creation unless the spirit of God has hovered over the earth.

Redemption

Jesus told the Samaritan woman, ***“but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” (John 4:14).*** The spring of water is the Holy Spirit. Jesus was telling the Samaritan woman that no one could become born again unless the Spirit of God comes upon him.

Analogy N°3: the issue of darkness

Creation

Genesis 1:3 “And God said, “Let there be light,” and there was light.”

When the light showed on the earth, God solved the first problem: darkness.

Redemption

John 8:12 “When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.”

John 1:5 “The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it.”

At redemption, when Jesus comes in a heart, darkness disappears. The first problem that God solves at redemption is the problem of darkness, just as he did at creation. God had used creation, for us to understand what Jesus would do at redemption. Everything is dark before there is light.

Analogy N°4: The issue of formlessness

Creation

Genesis 1:4-5 “God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light “day”, and the darkness he called “night. And there was evening, and there was morning, the first day.”

The first thing God said after creating the light, was to separate light from darkness. In producing form, the keyword is separation. The first form came up: **day and night**.

Genesis 1:6-8 “And God said, “Let there be an expanse between the waters to separate water from water.” So God made the expanse and separated the water under the expanse from the water above it. And it was so. God called the expanse “sky”. And there was evening, and there was morning, the second day”

God continued the separation. Another form came up: the sky. We see that creation is not a story. It is God at work.

Genesis 1:9-10 “And God said, “Let the water under the sky be gathered to one place, and let dry ground appear.” And it was so. God called the dry ground “land,” and the gathered waters he called “seas”. And God saw that it was good.”

God is continuing giving form: **the land and the seas**. Now the waters are gathering. There is only one world map: the Pacific Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Indian Ocean and the Antarctic Ocean. Everywhere you go to the world, the world map does not change, because God has given form through separation.

Genesis 1:14 “And God said, “Let there be lights in the expanse of the sky to separate the day from the night, and let them serve as signs to mark seasons and days and years, and let them be lights in the expanse of the sky to give light on the earth.” And it was so.”

Another separation takes place here. Therefore, we have four separations in total.

Redemption

Jesus at redemption will give form to the believer. When Jesus comes in the heart, the one who has received Christ separates from

- Sin,
- Darkness,
- The world,
- Bad friends,
- Places he used to go,
- Things he used to say, etc.

Those separations give the believer form and people begin to say that he has changed.

Analogy N°5: The issue of emptiness

Creation

Genesis 1:11 “Then God said, “Let the land produce vegetation: seed-bearing plants and trees on the land that bear fruit with seed in it, according to their various kinds.” And it was so.”

God was filling the earth because it was empty. He used seed-bearing plants and trees that bear fruits. God has not created many of the plants outside. In filling the earth, God preoccupation was fruit.

Redemption

When Jesus enters in the heart of a believer, he starts bearing fruit:

- ✓ The fruit of the spirit: ***love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. (Galatians 5:22-23)***
- ✓ By winning the lost to Christ.

The believer starts using the seeds God gave him (talents and gifts) to produce fruits for God.


If you study Genesis 1, you will realise that after God solved the problem of emptiness, he continued the separation until man was created. As we walk with God, separation is a process that continues with us until we get to perfection. If we have time to teach on creation, we will realise that may be all of our problems turn around the fact that there is a problem in separation. The root of all our problems in the Christian life.

The fruits and the type of fruits: John 15

When Jesus saw the fig tree, he was hungry and expecting fruit. Therefore, he cursed the fig tree when he found no fruit on it. The believer who does not bear fruit is empty and God has no use for him. Because at redemption, the problem was solved. God at creation produced seed-bearing plants. Therefore, at redemption, Jesus gives us talents, abilities in order to bear fruits. The believer is supposed to bear fruit in season and out of season. God is expecting us to bear fruit on a daily basis. When it comes to fruit, God is very thorough and furious when there is no fruit.

There are various types of fruits as depicted in John 15:




In verse 8, we see that the father begins to receive glory when the fruit becomes much.

Matthew 7: 15-20 “Watch out for false prophets. They come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ferocious wolves. By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thorn bushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them.”

When we are saved, the Holy Spirit comes upon us and we produce fruit. Every fruit according to his kind. The fruit that Tatiana will produce is according to Tatiana. The fruit that Manuela will produce is according to Manuela. She cannot produce fruits better than who she is. The fruits are produced according to the kind. A sin loving believer will produce sin loving converts. Good trees produce good fruits. And you know a good tree after it has undergone separation. Bad fruit will not abide. Only good fruit will abide.

John 15:16 “You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.”

Therefore, John 15:1-8 talks about quantity but in V16, it is all about the quality of the fruit. We must be careful about what kind of fruit we bear. First, Jesus chose us in order to bear fruit. However, Jesus is not talking about any type of fruit but fruit that will last. Some people want us to clap for them when they bear fruit, or clap just because they are there. We shall clap when your fruit will last.



**The closer we get to God and bear fruits,
God takes us to deeper levels of separation.**

After any encounter with God, you make new commitments of consecration. You decide to reduce the time you spend on your phone, you reduce the time you sleep, you increase your time of bible reading, you increase your time of prayer, etc. Every

increase in the consecration is linked to a separation from something. If you do not give up something, you cannot get into something. Without radical separation, continuous separation, there can be no radical consecration. As a man grows in separation, he also grows in consecration. When a person decides that separation has ended, he has also decided that growth has stopped.

What is redemption?

Redemption is everything that Jesus accomplished by his death at the cross, to transform mortal man to immortality. The salvation of the whole man: spirit – soul and body, so that the whole man is guaranteed for heaven.



What are the plants about which you said that God has not created them?

Genesis 3: 17-18 “To Adam he said, “Because you listened to your wife and ate from the tree about which I commanded you, “You must not eat of it”, “Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat of it all the days of your life. It will produce thorns and thistles for you, and you will eat the plants of the fields.”

When man sinned and the Lord cursed him, the Lord said that the soil is going to produce thorns and thistles. That are strange plants. The impact is enormous. If you see a beautiful rose, you cannot just go and cut it. The rose is so beautiful but it has thorns.

2 Kings 4:38-40 “Elisha returned to Gilgal and there was a famine in that region. While the company of the prophets was meeting with him, he said to his servant, “Put on the large pot and cook some stew for these men.” One of them went out into the fields to gather herbs and found a wild vine. He gathered some of tis gourds and filled the gold of his cloak. When he returned, he cut them up into the pot of stew, though no one knew what they were. The stew was poured out for the men, but as they began to eat it, they cried out, “O man of God, there is death in the pot!” And they could not eat it.”

Outside, there are herbs that cause death because of the sin of man. The sin of man brought death, wild plants. I do not think that man will ever realise what his sin has caused to the creation.

Part 2: what does creation has to do with us and with our ministry?

Creation continued. On the 6th day, there was a council in heaven between God the father, God the son and God the Holy Spirit. God had a job offer and he had a vice-regent to take care of the earth. There were two conditions to be fulfilled by man in order for him to be fruitful, to increase in number, to fill the earth, to subdue the earth and to have dominion:

- ✓ he had to be created in the image of God and
- ✓ he had to be created in the likeness of God.

The phases of our ministry

Genesis 1:28 "God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

The Lord created Adam and told him to:

1. Be fruitful

Adam and Eve had to produce their kind. God created man from scratch. God did not created the woman, the same way he created the man. Because God only has one original. Every other one comes from the original. The woman was taken out of the man. Since the man was at the image and likeness of God, the extraction from Adam was also at the image and likeness of God. Why did God proceed like this? The Lord said, ***"It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him."*** (Genesis 2:18).

Being a Helper fit means that the woman had to carry two responsibilities:

- ✓ She had to be the wife
- ✓ She had to be the co-worker N°1 of the man

This is the principle by which God raises competent co-workers. If God has to give the pastor a co-worker, that co-worker must carry the same characteristics. If not, he will one day leave. Therefore, when Adam woke up from his sleep, he looked at the woman and said, "This is bone of my bone, flesh of my flesh". You cannot be the co-worker of somebody without being bone of his bone or flesh of his flesh, meaning without a resemblance. The earth was to be filled with Adam's kind. That is what is called the making of disciples.

- 2. Increase in numbers**
- 3. Fill the earth**
- 4. Subdue the earth**
- 5. Rule (dominate) over it**

God divided the goal he gave to Adam in 5 phases. Adam would only have power to dominate over the earth after he had increased in number and filled the earth. For Adam to be fruitful and have dominion, he must remain in the image and likeness of God. God does not compromise that element. When Adam disobeyed God, he was no longer at the image and likeness of God. Therefore, he lost dominion over the creation. That is why there are wild animals. That is why the serpent became wild. That is why the lion feeds on other animals. That is why thorns and thistles began to fill the earth. That is why diseases came on earth. The issue of subduing the earth became laborious.

Back to our goal

Our goal is precise. A man is supposed to ask himself, what must I do

- ✓ today,
- ✓ this week,
- ✓ this month,
- ✓ this year in order to accomplish the goal.

The Lord told Brother Zach, the recipient of our vision to divide the goal in 5 phases:

<i>Phase 1</i>	100 000 disciples in 50 nations
<i>Phase 2</i>	1 000 000 disciples in 100 nations
<i>Phase 3</i>	10 000 000 disciples in 150 nations
<i>During the convention</i>	1.000.000 disciple makers in whose life a particular message, God gave us, must be manifested
<i>Phase 3</i>	1.000.000 house churches of at least 50 members
<i>Phase 4</i>	500.000.000 disciples in 200 nations
<i>Phase 5</i>	1.000.000.000 disciples in 250 nations

What does the image and likeness of God mean?

When you look at the mirror, you see your image. What you see is the image, what you do not see is the likeness. The inner characteristics of God is the likeness of God. When God created man, he put in him his love, his joy, his kindness, his righteousness.... The outward manifestation is what people see and that is called the image of God. If I tell a brother that I love him, I have to manifest that love. The inner characteristic is the likeness of God and the manifestation of that character is the image of God.

How are we concerned by all this?

God visited a certain young man named ZTF. God talked to him and he committed himself to obey to God in everything. ZTF therefore became a model, someone who maps out a way to follow. ZTF who became a **model** had to produce fruits, people like him, who are called **profiles**. These many profiles produce people like them. They are the one that we call disciples. The **disciples** are the ones who become the members of **the local church**. That is why when a church is made of disciples, it is a stable church. Disciples follow. Therefore, there are things that they do automatically. In other words, profiles imitate the model and disciples follow the profile. If the disciple sees that the profile gives to God sacrificially, he will also give sacrificially. Disciples are followers.

Local churches are not stable because the churches are not made of disciples. We have pastors who do not pay tithes, treasurers who are rubbers. We have leaders who sleep all night and miss prayer meetings. If you must follow a man, you must do what he does. We are burdened that the local churches will be made of disciples.

Mark 3:13-14 “Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to him those he wanted, and they came to him. He appointed twelve that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach...” In the school of Jesus, in the making of disciples, in the building of men, the disciples were supposed to see what he did and imitate. They saw how Jesus loved and they imitated. They saw how he lived, how he gave, rebuked and they imitated.

Acts 4:13 “When they saw the courage of Peter and John and realized that they were unschooled, ordinary men, they were astonished and they took note that these men had been with Jesus.” The people took note that the disciples had been with Jesus. They thought in themselves, that there was a man who had courage like this and these men are like him.

I used to monitor the life of Brother Zach. He usually shared his life with us. One day he told us that he so much wanted to read the Bible that he ran and locked up himself in his office and read 50 chapters of the Bible. I took a retreat immediately and read 100 chapters of my Bible in one goal. When he told us that he increased his giving, I also increased my giving. One day, Brother Zach told us that he would go on retreat for 21 days. I took a retreat of 7 days during the same period. During those 7 days, I read the bible for 8h40; I read the book “the ministry of fasting” during 9 hours and I was on a 7-day fast. On the 2nd day, I read for 23 hours.

Disciples are those who form the church and that is what will produce stability. The Lord Jesus said, that by their fruit you shall know them. It is not by what they say.

Mordecai told Esther, “if you don’t do anything, help will come from somewhere else”. Esther begged them to fast for her for 3 days. So, know that you are not indispensable.


If you do not make yourself available to serve God, God will use someone else. You should accept every opportunity that God gives you to serve him with humility. If you turn down the opportunity that God gave you to serve him, you refuse and turn it down by being arrogant, God will raise someone else. He will put you aside; He is not interested with arrogant people.

When the churches multiply, that is what we call the work. The work in Germany is all the local churches in all the cities put together. **The work** is the totality of the churches.

The **ministry** is the life that flows from the people of CMFI and that produce blessing in the life of others. Only disciples can be members of stable churches. Only disciples can be co-workers. When the disciples who are following a profile that has imitated the model, spread in the world, they carry the message.

Admiration produces following. You cannot follow someone until you admire him. To imitate, you must follow closely with admiration. Timothy admired Paul. However, at one point, Timothy became frightened. In **2 Timothy 1: 11-12**, Paul had to say to Timothy: ***“And of this gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher. That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet this is no cause for shame, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until that day.”*** Paul had to say to Timothy that for every call of God, there is a portion of suffering allocated. Timothy would not suffer like him. Because the young disciple may run away from following the person, he admires because of the lifestyle of the person. Brother Theodore is not going to suffer as Br Zach did. Because ZTF was to custodian of the vision. I will not suffer like Brother Theodore.

Gideon said, “look at me, do as I do”. So, Gideon was doing something that could be imitated. It is not possible to be indifferent towards the person you admire. When you admire the person so much, the person becomes your hero. To become a profile, look for the domain where your heart will flow, and be disciplined. Just do something different from everybody else. Commit yourself to do it.



Why did Adam fail?

There is a more serious problem. Why did Adam fail? Because he failed in being a model. Therefore, there is no continuity. When there is no profile, continuity ends. That is the problem we face right now. The goal that God has given to us to 2065, from the end of 2020, we shall have 45 years left. The question that we must ask is “will our ministry still continue till 2065 without profiles?” It is profiles who maintain the standards, who make sure that the standards that God has given to the model, are maintained.

When the Israelites asked God for a king, Samuel wept all night. This caused pain to Samuel because it was taking Israel away from how God has led Israel. Samuel has provided spiritual leadership for all Israel. He had four headquarters. He made a circle of all Israel each year. In each of his Headquarter, there was school of prophets. He wanted to produce prophets, people who will hear God and lead the people according to God’s way. Samuel made sure that Israel has God. Then the elders came saying, “Give us a king like other nations.” In a ministry, the leader hear God and provide leadership. In a denomination, there is a board meeting where the elders give their point of view. Saul was anointed king and a new pattern started in Israel. As we know, the Bible says in 1 chronicles that Saul died because he has been unfaithful to God.

Then God found David, a man after God's heart. The bible says, that when David died, Solomon was supposed to continue in the life and the ministry of David. However, Solomon loved foreign women and they turned his heart from God. Solomon did not continue the life of David. God found Jeroboam and told him:

- a. David is the model → follow the life of David
- b. I love Jerusalem

Jeroboam abandoned the ways of David and started the worship of idols in Dan. Therefore, he abandoned Jerusalem, the city of God. Although God has promised him an eternal kingdom if he obeys. Each time God tried to raise a profile that will follow the model, when he failed, there was a break.

Even with the prophets. Elijah followed the model of Samuel and then Elisha followed the model of Elijah. Then Gehazi complained about the consecration of his master, about the fact that this master refused Galatians 6:6. Elisha told him ***"Is it time to receive money and to receive clothing, olive groves and vineyards, sheep and oxen, male and female servants?" (2 King 5:26 b)***. Those words came to pass, because shortly after that, Gehazi became the counsellor of the king of Israel, with his leprosy. He had male servants and female servants. So, Israel did not have a prophet for many years to continue the prophetic ministry of Samuel. Because the person who was to become the next prophet was a lover of money.

The absence of profiles produces a break. If our ministry does not have profile, we shall not get to 2065. If you do not arise to exaggerate the strengths of our ministry, we shall not go far. We can follow two ways: the New Jerusalem or Babylon.



Let us pray that we continue to produce profiles who will make disciples.

My heart is bleeding for Europe. In 1993, we sent our first missionary couple to the Democratic Republic of Congo, with missionary allowance coming from Cameroon. Then our next missionary couple to Ghana went. In 1994, Brother Theodore was the

first missionary couple sent to Nigeria. In 1995, the Menye went to Cote d'Ivoire. Towards the end of 1996, we came to Britain as missionaries. Therefore, missionaries were leaving Cameroon and Brother Zach and the church in Yaoundé carried the missionary allowances. When we came as missionaries, the British government used to issue visas to missionaries. We had 2100 Pounds for 6 months. Allowances have been sent from Cameroon to us until 2002, when I asked Brother Zach to stop sending us allowances.

If Europe does not carry the relay, our ministry will have a standoff. If we wait for Cameroon, for Africa to continue to send missionaries to other nations, we are mistaken. If we wait that Cameroon and Africa continue to carry the financial burden and the spiritual burden of the ministry. A Cameroonian passport holder had access to maximum 45 countries, without visa. The third strongest passport in the world is the German passport. The strongest passport in the world now is the Japanese passport. It gives you access to 198 countries without visa or with visa on arrival. The second strongest passport is the one of Singapore, which gives you access to 197 countries; the third one is the German passport, giving access to 196 countries followed by the French passport and some others. The British passport gives you access to 194 countries. If you put all these countries together, you remove Japan, Singapore, USA and Canada, then all the countries remaining are European countries. I got a 5 years visa for India. India does not have an embassy in Cameroon.

Europe has to carry the relay with three responsibilities

1. ***In terms of human resources:*** Europe in the next five years must give our ministry 1000 missionaries for Europe, Asia and the Caribbean. Germany must ask, "what will be our contribution for this?" If you want our ministry to succeed, give us the men.
2. ***In terms of funds:*** A medical Doctor in Cameroon could earn about 300 € per month. Committed to God radically, he decides to give 50% to God, which will be 150 €. A person with a Bachelor degree in Europe could earn 2000 €.

Considering that we do not love God in Europe as in Africa, even if he gives only 10%, that will be 200 €. It is not righteous to depend on Cameroon for the advancement of our vision. Some of our brethren in Cameroon have given until there is nothing left to give. They have become dry.

3. ***The spiritual life***: we are not going to send missionaries because we are in need. When we take someone to send as a missionary, that person is a seed. We are going to plant you in the country where we are sending you. The question is what kind of seed are we going to plant? The kind of seed will determine the kind of fruit that we will produce.

For man to have dominion, it is not just about the numbers but also the kind of fruit. After Adam had sinned in Genesis 5, the bible says that he gave birth to a son after his image and his likeness. It was no longer the image and likeness of God. If the profile fails to imitate the model, we will fill the earth with the wrong kind of fruit. Consequently, we shall not have dominion. Because dominion has two characteristics: the spiritual power and the numbers. Spirituality and numbers give us dominion. We owe it to our ministry; we owe it to Brother Theodore. Europe is at the crest of the decision whether our ministry moves forwards or our ministry does not move forwards. We shall meet at Easter. God bless you.
